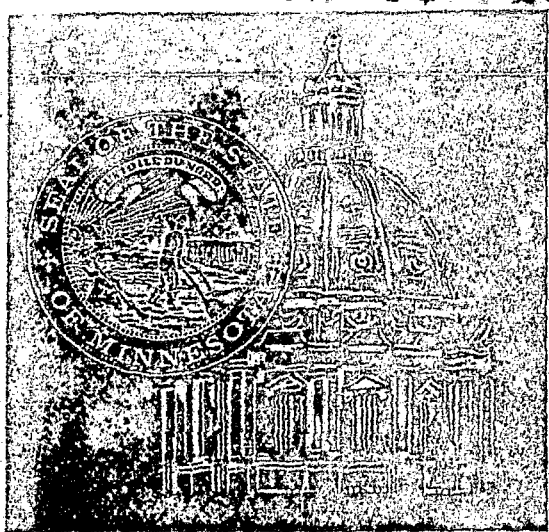




Proclamation

WHEREAS: the North Central Regional Meeting of the American Business Women's Association will be held in Bloomington, Minnesota, May 31, June 1 and June 2, 1974; and

WHEREAS: the American Business Women's Association is an educational association devoted to the advancement of women in business, and to the improvement of employer-employee relationships; and

WHEREAS: there are more than 75,000 active members in over 1,000 chapters of this organization throughout the country; and

WHEREAS: chapters in the Minneapolis and St. Paul area sponsor local educational scholarships annually, and join with other chapters throughout the United States in providing annual scholarships exceeding \$475,000, in addition to \$95,000 that is awarded in grants and interest-free loans from the Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of May 27 - June 3, 1974 as

AMERICAN BUSINESS WOMEN'S WEEK

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to take proper cognizance thereof.
