AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE  
VILLAGE OF JENKINS AND INCORPORATING ADDITIONAL TER-  
RITORY THEREIN

The Village Council of the Village of Jenkins does ordain  
as follows:

Section I.

A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Jenkins, Minnesota, by the owner of the following described tract of real estate to have such tract included within the Village of Jenkins, Minnesota:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 35, Township 137, Range 29, thence East 990 feet, thence South 1,320 feet, thence West 990 feet, thence North 1,320 feet to the place of beginning.

Section II.

The above described land is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres, and the petitioners, LaVerne L. Wahl and Vera Ann Wahl, are the sole owners of said property.

Section III.

Notice of the filing of the petition has been filed with the Town Board of Jenkins Township, the Crow Wing County Board of Commissioners, the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the Village of Jenkins, at least sixty (60) days prior to the first reading of this Ordinance, and that no objections have been received thereto.

Section IV.

All fees required to be paid by the Petitioners have been duly paid.

Section V.

The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Jenkins, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section VI.

Therefore, the Village of Jenkins, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Jenkins, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section VII.

This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Village Clerk of Jenkins Township, the Crow Wing County Auditor, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.
