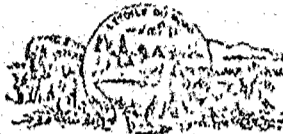

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Hamburg has determined that certain lands in the Town of Young America are bordered by the corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg on more than 60 per cent of their perimeter, and that said lands, as provided by Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033 may be annexed by Ordinance of the Village of Hamburg unless objections thereto are filed within 60 days of receipt by the Town of Young America of a Notice as provided by said Section 414.033; and

WHEREAS, such Notice was served upon the Town Clerk of the Town of Young America on the 17 day of January, 1974, and more than sixty (60) days have passed since such service and no objections thereto have been filed by the Town of Young America or any other party:

The Village Council of the Village of Hamburg, Carver County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below is bordered by the corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg on more than 60 per cent of its perimeter; that said lands are not now included in any other municipality; that said lands are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government; and that annexation of said lands would be in the best interests of the Village of Hamburg and of the territory to be annexed.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point $25\frac{1}{2}$ rods North of the Southeast corner of Section 29, Township 115 North of Range 26 West; thence running North along the Section line between Sections 28 and 29, a distance of 337 feet to a point, which point is the point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence continuing North on said same line a distance of 34,655 feet to a point which is 788.28 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section 29, Township 115 North of Range 26 West as measured along the East line thereof; thence on a bearing of North $89^{\circ} 35' 00''$ West parallel with the South line of said Section 29 for a distance of 165.00 feet; thence on a bearing of South, parallel with said East line of Section 29, a distance of 34,655 feet to a point; thence South $89^{\circ} 35' 00''$ East parallel with said South line of Section 29 a distance of 165.00 feet to the actual point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and the Auditor of Carver County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be deemed final upon the filing of the copies of this Ordinance as directed in Section 3 and publication as provided by law.



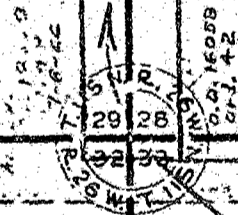

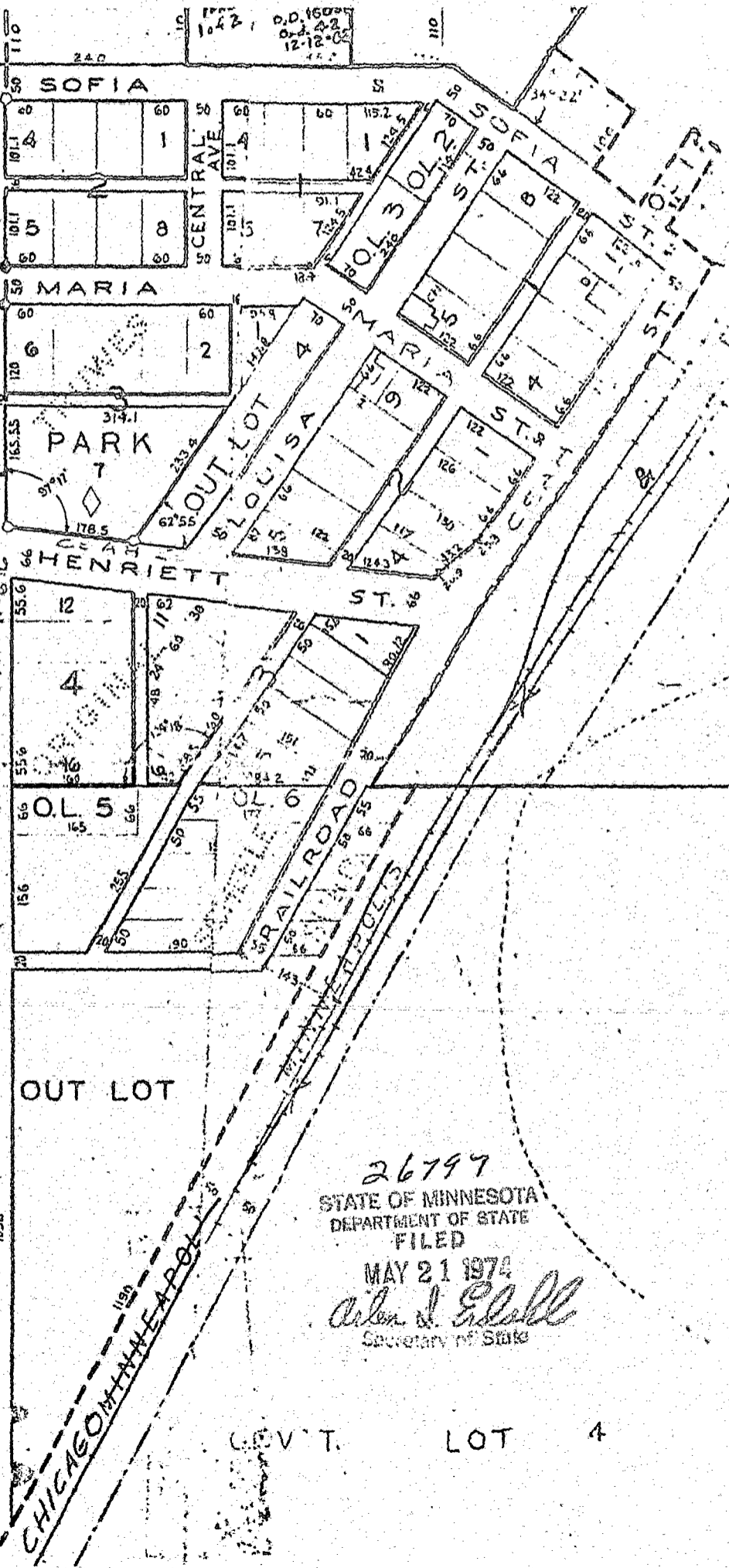
