AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MANCHESTER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Manchester, Minnesota, signed by the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Manchester, Minnesota:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the NEW SEW Section 15, Township 103 North, Pange 22 West, which point is 795.35 feet West of the northeast corner thereof; thence West 100.00 feet on the North line of said quarter quarter section; thence South 140.00 feet at a right angle; thence East 100.00 feet at a right angle; thence North 140.00 feet at a right angle, to the point of beginning: being part of the NE4 SE4 Section 15, Township 103 North, Range 22 West and containing 0.32 acres; subject to highway easement on the North side thereof.
