

Proclamation

WHEREAS: the importance of American Fathers in helping to develop the fundamental characteristics of integrity, loyalty, leadership, brotherhood and responsibility in their children is realized and appreciated by all; and

WHEREAS: our identity in name and nature, our roots in home and family, and more is the heritage our fathers share with us; and

WHEREAS: to have a father -- to be a father -- is to come very near the heart of life itself; and

WHEREAS: Congress passed a joint resolution, long overdue, on April 24, 1972 designating the third Sunday in June of each year to be Father's Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 16, 1974 to be

FATHER'S DAY

in Minnesota, and urge every member of our society to take the time to remember and appreciate the contributions made by all Fathers to the quality of life.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
