PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, the chief of police and two other peace officers of the village of Hibbing, St. Louis County, on September eighth, 1931, were killed while attempting to arrest one John Webb, in said St. Louis County, on a charge of committing a felony, and


WHEREAS, the said John Webb, who murdered the said peace officers, is still at large, and public welfare demands his apprehension and punishment,

NOW THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the State Treasury, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars as a reward for the arrest, or for information leading to the arrest of the said John Webb.
