

ORDINANCE NO. 359

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owner of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

That part of the South One-half (S½) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of Section 26, Township 139 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Southeast Quarter as evidenced by an existing iron monument; thence North 01 degree 11 minutes 12 seconds East 1066.44 feet on an assumed bearing along the West line of said Southeast Quarter to the point of beginning; thence South 01 degree 11 minutes 12 seconds West to the North line of the South One-half of the South One-half of said Southeast Quarter; thence Easterly along the North line of said South One-half of the South One-half of the Southeast Quarter to the waters edge of the Pelican River; thence Northeasterly and Northerly along the waters edge of said Pelican River to the intersection with a line which bears South 89 degrees 34 minutes 39 seconds East from the point of beginning; thence North 89 degrees 34 minutes 39 seconds West 1207.77 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. The above described tract contains 12.0 acres, more or less. SUBJECT to any easements and reservations that may affect the above described tract.


Section 2. The City Council hereby determines: (1) that the annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the city government.

Section 3. Therefore, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to, and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.




