ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY AND EXTENDING CITY LIMITS

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, does hereby
ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that that tract
of land situated in Lac Qui Parle County, Minnesota, described as follows:

In Johnson's Addition to Dawson; all of Johnson Street
and block Five (5) less the south two-hundred fifty feet
(S. 250') thereof according to the map or plat thereof on
file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds
in and for Lac Qui Parle County, Minnesota.

abuts on and lies immediately north from and is surrounded on at least 60% of
its periphery by city limits of the City of Dawson and is adaptable to urban
government and commercial development, and it is in the best interests of the
City of Dawson that the above-described territory be annexed to the City of
Dawson for all government purposes.

Section 2. That it is hereby found that the Town Board of the Town
of Riverside, by its resolution passed and adopted December 26, 1973, waives all
right of objection to and hearing on annexation of said territory otherwise per-
mitted by pertinent statutes and consents to annexation of said territory by the
City of Dawson.

Section 3. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof is
hereby annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes and that the
city limits of the City of Dawson are hereby extended and enlarged to include the
same, and that all of said territory is hereby zoned as commercial property and is
assigned to and made a part of the first ward of the City of Dawson.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after final
passage and publication and that true and correct copies thereof be forwarded to
and filed with Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Lac Qui Parle
County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
