



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Division of the American Cancer Society is a voluntary organization of approximately 70,000 who are united to combat cancer by means of life-saving programs of research, education and service to cancer patients; and

WHEREAS: nationally some 2.25 million Americans unite each year to conquer cancer; and

WHEREAS: in 1974 these volunteers are led by Mr. Peter Graves, the national American Cancer Society Crusade Chairman and star of television and screen; and

WHEREAS: on May 13, 1974 Mr. Peter Graves will appear in Minnesota for the purpose of meeting and supporting the work of all Minnesota Division volunteers in their quest to raise \$1,250,000 in 1974 to continue the cancer fight;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, May 13, 1974 to be

PETER GRAVES DAY

in Minnesota and urge every citizen of our state to observe this day by increasing his support of the American Cancer Society and its life-saving programs, and by learning the facts about cancer and its warning signals to protect themselves from this disease.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
