



Proclamation

WHEREAS: June 14 has been recognized as "Flag Day", and has been observed over the Nation with the flying of the American flag; and

WHEREAS: there is increased interest in the flying of the flag as a symbol of the greatness of our country; and

WHEREAS: the flying of the flag on a continuous basis is a reminder for our people to keep alive the Spirit of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 14, 1974 as

FLY THE FLAG DAY

in Minnesota as part of the National "Fly the Flag Crusade", which movement urged the flying of the flag daily over every home in America, culminating in 1976 - our 200th birthday - with the flying of the United States flag over every home and business and institution in our country as a symbol of our solidarity in our Nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
