



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the motorcycle is a recognized economical, convenient and recreational means of transportation; and*

WHEREAS: *the motorcycle is entitled to all the rights, privileges and other benefits enjoyed by the other types of motor vehicle traffic; and*

WHEREAS: *the State Department of Public Safety recognizes the motorcycle as a true member of the vehicular society which must be driven in accordance with the rules of the road; and*

WHEREAS: *the safe use of motorcycles in our state is a matter of concern for all and with the need for the driving public to make a concerted effort to promote motorcycle-automobile safety;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 23 - 29, 1974 as

EYE THAT CYCLE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge industries, schools, civic and service organizations, business groups and parents to cooperate in this observance in public and private in order that the well-being of our motorcyclists and other users of our streets and highways may be safeguarded.
