O R D E R

The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition by the land-owners for the detachment of land from the City of Ogilvie, Minnesota on the 27th day of November, 1973 and an amended petition on the 15th day of July, 1974. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was received from the City of Ogilvie on the 27th day of November, 1973 and an amended resolution on the 15th day of July, 1974.

The territory involved consists of the following:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) lying North of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway in Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-nine (39), North of Range Twenty-five (25) West; The Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-nine (39) North of Range Twenty-five (25) West. Owners are Orville L. and Virginia Harris, husband and wife.

The Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-nine (39), Range Twenty-five (25), except railroad right of way, owned by Fred E. Birch.

The property is located adjacent to the Township of Kanabec, Kanabec County and said lands are unplatted and used for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission hereby issues its Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property


be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Ogilvie and made a part of the Township of Kanabec, Kanabec County, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the City of Ogilvie, be and the same hereby is decreased by seven (7) for all purposes until the next federal census.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the Township of Kanabec be and the same hereby is increased by seven (7) for all purposes until the next federal census.
