



Proclamation

WHEREAS: one of the greatest resources possessed by our Nation and State is the talent and energy of our teenage citizens; and

WHEREAS: the need for work experience by teenagers is great as is the need for employment as revealed in employment statistics released by the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS: the Rent-A-Kid program, sponsored by the Neighborhood First Banks of the Twin City Area, the YMCA of Metropolitan Minneapolis and the St. Paul Area YMCA, is meeting this employment need by providing part-time employment opportunities for hundreds of teenagers during the summer months; and

WHEREAS: there is a need for Minnesota citizens to know that teenagers can be employed through Rent-A-Kid and that citizens can help in this effort by providing part-time employment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, July 11, 1974 as

RENT-A-KID DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to support this program whenever and wherever they can by providing teenagers an opportunity to work.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
