



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: Jack Jorgensen came to Minnesota from North Dakota in 1941 as a young man and was elected an officer in Teamsters Local 359 and the Teamsters Joint Council; and

WHEREAS: since 1943 he has been president of the Teamsters Joint Council 32; and

WHEREAS: he also serves as Secretary-Treasurer of Teamsters Local 359; and

WHEREAS: under Jack Jorgensen's leadership, the Teamsters and other independent labor forces have cooperated with the DFL in gaining mutually beneficial ends; and

WHEREAS: civic and humanitarian causes have had the support of Jack Jorgensen for many years; and

WHEREAS: he is a trustee of the Minnesota Children's Health Center, a director of the American Trade Union Council for Histradrut, a member of the Hennepin County Park Reserve District, a director of the Minnesota Institute of Arts, a member of the University of Minnesota Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS: Jack Jorgensen was recently appointed to the Metropolitan Airports Commission; and

WHEREAS: Jack Jorgensen's contribution to the labor movement in Minnesota is widely acknowledged; and

WHEREAS: for 33 years, Jack Jorgensen has fought many battles for his members and won for them a better life; and

WHEREAS: this achievement has helped to enrich the life of all Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Jack Jorgensen has reached the age of sixty years with grace and dignity; and

WHEREAS: he is being honored on his birthday, July 25, by his friends and associates;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, July 25 to be
