Dear Sir:

In conformity with the specifications provided by your department for furnishing motor vehicle number plates we propose to manufacture and deliver in accordance with those specifications in the basement of the State Capital in the City of St Paul the entire quantity of motor plates mentioned in your specifications to be made of 24 gauge U.S. standard black steel with two coats of enamel and to be inclosed in a 60 pound kraft envelope at a price of 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per pair. (14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢)

Should the State of Minnesota require an envelope similar manufactured to Duplex envelope which was used with our tags supplied during 1931 this will add to the above price 1.6¢ per pair.

Provided the motor vehicle number plate Contract is awarded to us we will agree to manufacture the motor cycle plates in accordance with specifications at a price of 8¢ each to be delivered at State Capital in the City of St Paul.

We beg to state that this Company is the owner of a complete plant for the manufacture of Auto License Plate equipped with the most modern machinery and capable of turning out 5M pairs of plates per day, that this plant is located at 3127 Tilden Street in the City of Chicago, that the bidder has the metal required for the tags bid on purchased and is in a position to make delivery in accordance with time specified in your proposal.
