visions of Chapter 414.033 of the Minnesota Statutes Annotated, and


WHEREAS, a copy of the petition has been duly filed with the

be in the best interests of the Town of Livonia,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Statutes Annotated.


2. Be it further resolved, that the Town Clerk and Town
