ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE
VILLAGE OF BYRON

(SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 32, Township 107,
Range 15, are hereby annexed to the Village of Byron, to wit:

DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES: All that part of the Southwest Quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 32, Township
107, Range 15, lying South of the Chicago-Northwestern Railroad
Right of Way as now located in said quarter section, except that
part of said premises which was heretofore annexed to the Village
of Byron and platted as Cheery Meadows First Subdivision.
