Sir:

We, the undersigned members of the Council of the Village of Cooley, do hereby certify that at a special election held in said Village of Cooley on the 15th, day of October, 1921, called for the purpose of determining whether or not the Village of Cooley should be constituted a separate election and assessment district, there were 46 votes cast, and that 43 of such votes were in favor of constituting said Village a separate election and assessment district and 3 votes were against said proposition. One ballot declared spoiled.

We therefore certify and return to you that as a result of said election said Village has determined to become a special election and assessment district, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 1238 of the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913.
