

WHEREAS, said Ordinance Number 332 of said City is and remains a true and legal document, and

WHEREAS, the revised property description attached hereto and made a part hereof in no way alters the meaning or intent of said ordinance, nor does it make a change thereto that is of substantive nature, and

WHEREAS, it has been judged by the City's legal counsel to be proper and fitting to use interchangeably the attached clarifying property description for the description in said ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Morris that the attached property description be filed with and attached to Ordinance Number 332 to "clarify" the legal description in said ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new property description be submitted to the Municipal Commission as a true and correct description of the property annexed by Ordinance Number 332 and caused to be incorporated as part of the City of Morris in the County of Stevens, State of Minnesota.

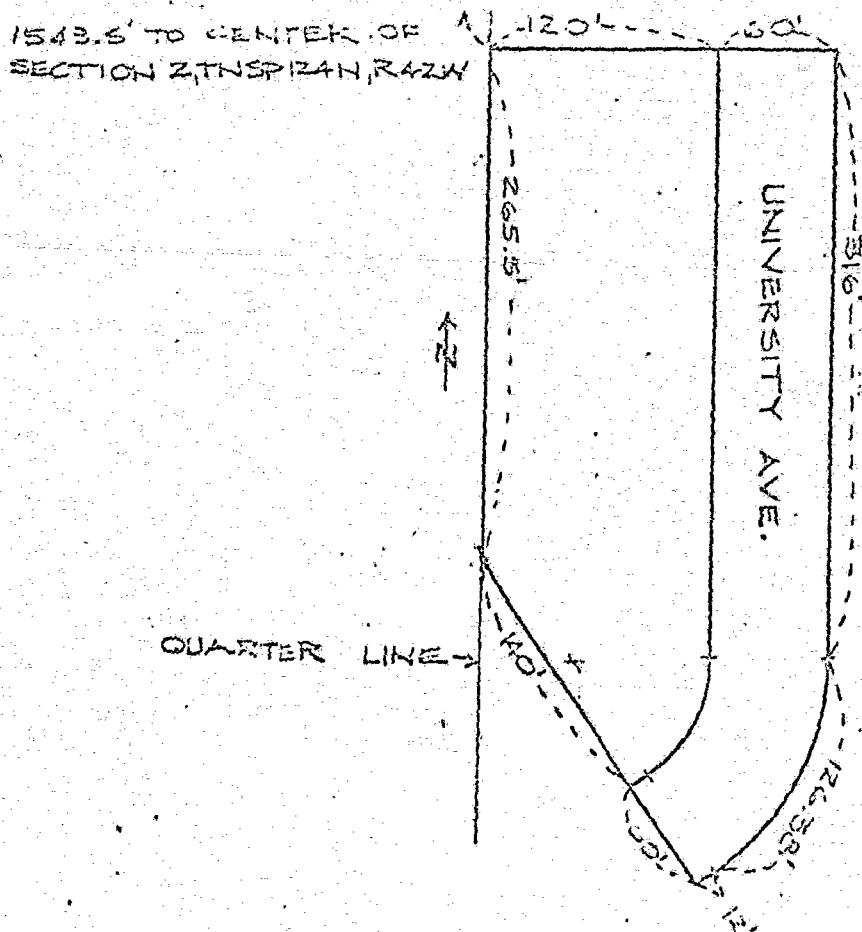

Clarification of Property Description for
Ordinance 332 of the City of Morris, Minnesota

MAY 16 1974

That part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 2, Township 124 North, Range 42 West, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1543.5 feet South of the center of said Section 2, Township 124 N, Range 42 W, which point is the Southwest corner of the Elles Addition to the City of Morris. Thence East along the South boundary of said Elles Addition a distance of 180 feet. Thence South along the East right-of-way line of University Avenue a distance of 316 feet to a point; said point being a point of curvature on the said East right-of-way of University Avenue. Thence continuing on the East right-of-way of said University Avenue along a curve having a radius of 130 feet an arc distance of 126.38 feet, more or less. Thence continuing Southwesterly along the East right-of-way line of said University Avenue a distance of 12 feet to a point; said right-of-way line being tangent to a forementioned curve and perpendicular to the Northeasterly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 9; said point on the Northeasterly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 9. Thence proceeding Northwesterly along the Northeasterly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 9 a distance of 200 feet to the quarter line of said Section 2. Thence North and along the quarter line of said Section 2 a distance of 265.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.82 acres, more or less.
