Section 805—Annexation  
The following parcel of land, being petitioned for annexation upon 100 per cent petition by Harry P. Hanson and Helen T. Hanson, is hereby annexed to the Village of Geneva:

Said newspaper has complied with all requirements of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 331 and is a legal newspaper.

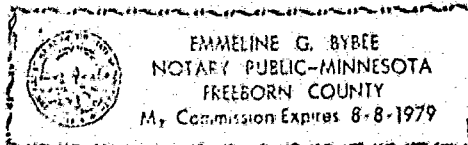
