ORDINANCE NO. 240

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE A CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND AREA, THE PERIMETER OF WHICH IS 60% OR MORE BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain lands described below are not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, said lands being situated in Grand Forks Township, Polk County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Sixty (60%) percent or more of the perimeter of the lands hereinafter described are bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and are deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, Notice of Intent to Annex said lands as hereinafter described was served upon all members of the Town Board of Grand Forks Township, on the 9th day of February, 1972, and more than sixty (60) days have elapsed and no objections to said annexation have been served upon the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, by the said Town Board.

The City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted lands described as follows, sixty (60%) percent or more of the perimeter of said lands being bordered by lands already included within the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, limits, to-wit:

A tract of land in Section 34, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, which tract is comprised of the southerly 304.00 feet of the Easterly 1268.00 feet of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) of said Section 34 and also of Government Lots 2 and 3 of said Section 34, which Government Lots 2 and 3 comprise Whalstrom's Subdivision of Lots 2 & 3, Sec. 34, Twp. 152 N., Rng. 50 W., Polk County, Minnesota, said tract being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 34, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian and thence proceeding southerly along the East line of Section 34 for a distance of 1016.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence continuing southerly along the East line of Section 34 for a distance of 1958.10 feet more or less to the waters edge of the Red River of the North; thence deflecting right and proceeding in a westerly-northwesterly direction along the waters edge of the Red River of the North for a distance of 3299 feet more or less to an intersection with the Subdivision line in said Section 34 which line forms the North line of Whalstrom's Subdivision of Government Lots 2 & 3, Sec. 34, Twp. 152 N., R. 50 W.; thence deflecting right and proceeding easterly along said Subdivision line for a distance of 1528.75 feet more or less to a point on said Subdivision line which, when measured along said subdivision line, lies 1268.00 feet west of the East line of said Section 34; thence deflecting left and proceeding northerly on a line lying parallel to the East line of Section 34, for a distance of 304.00 feet; thence deflecting right and proceeding easterly on a line lying parallel to the Subdivision line for a distance of 1268.00 feet to the true point of beginning, said described tract comprised of 78,573 acres in Section 34, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, County of Polk, State of Minnesota.

Section 2. Filing. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Grand Forks Township, the County Auditor of Polk County and Secretary of State of Minnesota.

Section 3. Effective Date of Ordinance. This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2, and be given the number 240.
