## ORDINANCE NO. 240

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS, MINNESOTA, TO IN-CLUDE A CERTAIN UNINCOR-PORATED LAND AREA, THE PERIMETER OF WHICH IS 60% OR MORE BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON. WHEREAS, Certain lands de-scribed below are not presently in-cluded within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or bar-ough, said lands being situated in Grand Forks Township, Polk County, Minnesota; and WHEREAS, Sixty (60%) percent or more of the perimeter of the lands hereinalter described are bor-dered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and are deemed to be utban in character; and WHEREAS, Notice of Intent to

The City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, do hereby ordain as follows: Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the plat-ted and unplatted lands described as follows, sixty (60%) percent or more of the perimeter of said lands being bordared by lands already in-cluded within the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, limits, to-wit: .'
