AUDITOR'S CERTIFICATE OF THE CREATION
OF SEPERATE ASSESSMENT AND ELECTION DISTRICT.

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE

I, Thomas Erskine, Auditor of Itasca County, Minnesota, do hereby certify that the Village of Coleraine in Itasca County, Minnesota, has been created as a separate assessment and election district by the separation of said village from the towns of Iron Range and Trout Lake by an election held pursuant to Section 1238 of the General Statutes of Minnesota for the year 1913, and that the attached is a true and correct copy of all papers that have been filed in my office relating to the separation of said Village of Coleraine from the towns of Iron Range and Trout Lake for separate assessment and election purposes showing that on the 21st day of October, 1921, at a special election held in the Village of Coleraine upon the question of whether the Village of Coleraine should be constituted an election and assessment district separate from the towns of Iron Range and Trout Lake, 248 votes were cast upon said proposition, 240 of which were in favor thereof and 8 against the same.

I therefore certify that from the records on file in my office it does appear that the result of said election was in favor of the separation of said Village of Coleraine from the towns of Iron Range and Trout Lake and do certify the result of said election to you as required by the section of the law above stated.

CERTIFICATE AND RETURN OF THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE VILLAGE OF COLERAINE, IN ITASCA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ON October 22, 1921, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION: "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF COLERAINE, IN ITASCA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, BE CONSTITUTED A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, SEPARATE FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF IRON RANGE AND SEPARATE FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF TROUT LAKE, IN SAID COUNTY OF ITASCA, AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT PURPOSES?"

Village of Coleraine:

We do hereby certify and return that at a Special Village Election, held in the Fire Department Room of the Village Hall in said Village of Coleraine, in the County of Itasca and State of Minnesota, on the 21st day of October, 1921, to vote on the following proposition: "Shall the Village of Coleraine, in Itasca County, State of Minnesota, be constituted a separate election and assessment district, separate from the Township of Iron Range and separate from the Township of Trout Lake, in said County of Itasca, and State of Minnesota, for election and assessment purposes?" The following number of votes were cast for and against said proposition, as canvassed by us, to-wit:

There were cast in favor of said proposition 240^{votes.} There were cast against said proposition 8 votes.

Upon the canvass of the returns of said election by the Village Council of said Village on October 22, 1921, the proposition was duly declared carried favorably.
