



Proclamation

WHEREAS: children and youth with special learning disabilities, who are of normal or potentially normal intelligence but are handicapped by a disorder in one or more of the basic learning patterns involved in understanding or in using language; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association for Children with Learning Disabilities is a non-profit organization dedicated to the advancement of the education and general welfare of these children and youth; and

WHEREAS: the sixth state-wide conference on learning disabilities in Minnesota will be held in Minneapolis, November 21 - 23, 1974, under the sponsorship of the Minnesota Association for Children with Learning Disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 17 - 23, 1974 as

LEARNING DISABILITIES WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all parents, educators and physicians to focus their special attention on early recognition and seek appropriate remediation for these children and youth, so that they may develop to their full potential as contributing members of society.
