



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the foundation of our nation's economy is based upon the ability of the working people of our land to be able to buy back the fruits of their toil; and

WHEREAS: the distinguished emblems of the Unions of the American trade union movement are living symbols of improved conditions, better wages and increased security brought to the workers of our land through the attainments of the trade union movement and through the processes of collective bargaining; and

WHEREAS: the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations and its national Union Label and Service Trades Department, which sponsors and produces UNION LABEL WEEK, have unanimously designated the period of September 2-8, 1974 as UNION LABEL WEEK;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of September 2 - 8, 1974 as

UNION LABEL WEEK

in Minnesota, and call upon all citizens to observe this week as a tribute to organized labor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
