



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the well-being of our citizens depends on the health of our economy; and*

WHEREAS: *the principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability; and*

WHEREAS: *a better understanding of freedom of enterprise by the people of Minnesota would help preserve and strengthen our free economy;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 25 to 31, 1974 as

FREEDOM OF ENTERPRISE WEEK

and urge our citizens to acquaint themselves with the principles of freedom of enterprise and to avail themselves of the special opportunities provided during this observance by Kiwanis Clubs throughout the State of Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
