WHEREAS: one of the greatest resources possessed by our Nation and State is the talent and wisdom of older Americans; and

WHEREAS: in Minnesota, more than ten percent of our total population, or nearly 410,000 persons, are 65 or older; and

WHEREAS: these individuals can offer priceless experience and mature judgment in helping us to build the future of this nation on the fundamental lessons of the past; and

WHEREAS: we are mindful of the needs of our senior citizens and have a deep concern and commitment to programs of service to our elderly citizens; and

WHEREAS: a special day at the Minnesota State Fair has been planned for seniors on Thursday, August 29, 1974;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 29, 1974 to be

SENIOR CITIZENS DAY

at the State Fair.
