



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Labor Day Holiday weekend, Sunday, September 1, 1974 marks the date of the "Jerry Lewis Telethon 1974" to benefit Muscular Dystrophy Associations of America, Inc. for public support of its fight against a relentlessly crippling disease; and

WHEREAS: the health of this Nation, so vital to its welfare and security, is endangered by any disease whose cause and cure is unknown, and whose victims number some 1,000,000 of our citizens; and

WHEREAS: - these victims, the majority of whom are children, derive comfort and hope from
- MDAA's comprehensive program of patient care, camping -- recreation and research;

WHEREAS: the scope of MDAA's research program -- which includes the research grant and support of a major research center at the Mayo Clinic -- also brings hope to millions suffering from related neuromuscular diseases;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Labor Day Weekend, September 1 & 2, 1974 as

JERRY LEWIS TELETHON WEEKEND

and call upon all citizens of our State to give full support to the work of Muscular Dystrophy Associations of America, Inc.;

AND I FURTHER PROCLAIM Joey Beckman, the 1974 Muscular Dystrophy State Poster Child.
