Be it resolved by the Council for the City of
Dilworth:

THAT elections for City Council will be held on
odd numbered years and that to accomplish this, the terms of
office for Jack Boyle, Quentin Kienholz, and Robert Chrissis
will be extended by one year.

THAT the next elections for council position shall
be for four-year terms.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall
take effect on March 22, 1974.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The City council has adopted Ordinance No. 74-1 establishing the odd-numbered years as Biennial Election Years in the City of Dilworth, and setting the Councilmen's terms at four (4) years each, and

WHEREAS 1974 is not an election year in the City of Dilworth, but the City Council wishes to determine, by the vote of the people, whether the Mayor's term of office shall remain at two (2) years or be made a four (4) year term,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Dilworth, Clay County, Minnesota that a Special Election be held on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November 1974 and that the Ballot for said election shall have on it, one question to be voted on, asking the people if, beginning with the Mayor elected in the 1975 City Election, if the Mayor's term of office shall be for two (2) years or four (4) years.
