

PRINTER'S AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(Chapter 474, Effective May 20, 1965)

F. G. Clasen being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the editor publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The Anoka County Union and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Anoka in the County of Anoka and it has its known office of issue in the City of Anoka in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by Arch G. Pease or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by Arch G. Pease and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance No. 31

ORDINANCE NO. 31
CITY OF HAM LAKE
COUNTY OF ANOKA
STATE OF MINNESOTA
AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE STATUTORY CITY ELECTION DATE.
The City Council of the City of Ham Lake, Anoka County, Minnesota, does ordain:
SECTION 1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 205.07, commencing with the 1975 City election, the regular City election of the City of Ham Lake, Anoka County, Minnesota, shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each odd numbered year and there shall be no regular City election in the year 1974.
SECTION 2. Whenever this change in the election year results in the expiration of any current term of office at a time when no City election is held in the month immediately prior thereto, each term is extended until the date for taking office following the next scheduled City election.
SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
