AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 38, OF THE VILLAGE (NOW CITY) OF LINO LAKES, ANOKA COUNTY, HINNESOTA, ADOPTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL ON THE 24TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1964; AND THIS ORDINANCE SETTING CITY ELECTIONS IN EACH ODD-NUTEERED YEAR AND ON THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER OF EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR.

The City Council of the City of Lino Lakes, Anoka County, Minnesota does ordain:

I.

Ordinance No. 38, of the Village (now City) of Lino Lakes, Anoka County, Minnesota, adopted by the Village Council on the 24th day of August, 1964, is hereby repealed.

II

Commencing with the 1975 City Election, the regular City Election of the City of Lino Lakes, Anoka County, Minnesota, shall be held in each odd-numbered year on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in Hovember of each odd-numbered year.

III

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
