V. Ordinance Providing for Odd-Year City Elections and Regulating Initial Terms of Office

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE DATE OF THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION, EXTENDING THE TERM
OF COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR ONE YEAR WHERE NECESSARY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE YEAR WHEN CERTAIN COUNCILMEN ARE TO BE ELECTED

THE CITY COUNCIL OF M. Tilail ORDAINS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The regular city election shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every odd-numbered year, beginning with the 1975 election. There shall be no regular city election in 1974.

Section 2. Extension of Terms of Council Members. The term of the councilman whose current term will expire on the first business day of January, 1975 is extended to the first business day of January, 1976, and that office shall be filled at the 1975 city election. 1

Section 3. Terms and Transition. Two council members shall be elected for four-year terms at each biennial city election commencing in 1975.2 The mayor shall be elected for a two-year term at each such election.3
