WHEREAS: *the tragedy of cancer is all too well known to millions of Americans because of the grief that accompanies it; and*

WHEREAS: *there are few families in this country which have not been affected in some way by this dread disease; and*

WHEREAS: *the United Cancer Institute proposes that Neighborhood Cancer Detection, Education and Research Centers be constructed in cities across the United States; and*

WHEREAS: *it is the belief of the medical profession that Cancer is curable if detected and treated in its early stages and that this practice would result in the savings of millions of lives each year;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 8, 1974 as

NATIONAL CANCER DAY

in Minnesota.
