WHEREAS: during his 12 years as president, Philip W. Pillsbury pioneered the firm's move into home baking and bakery mixes, and expanded it into the formula feed business; and

WHEREAS: the Philip W. Pillsbury research and development facility in Minneapolis is a testimonial to his determination to strengthen this department; and

WHEREAS: Philip W. Pillsbury serves on the executive boards of numerous social, civic and educational groups, is a member of the board of directors of several large corporations and was appointed honorary French consul for the Upper Midwest in 1966; and

WHEREAS: in commemoration of the Golden Anniversary of Philip W. Pillsbury with the Minnesof food industry, a park bearing his name will be dedicated today in front of the old Pillsbury A Mill on Northeast Main Street in Minneapolis;
