

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, to Include Certain Lands Owned by the City of Willmar, and Repealing Portions of Ordinance No. 606.

Whereas, the following described land is owned by the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and

Whereas, said property abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as to be properly subject to City Government and since annexation thereof will be in the best interests of the City of Willmar and of the property to be annexed.

Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Willmar as follows:

Section 1. Annexation. The following described property is hereby annexed and included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That part of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

The South 575 feet of the West 660 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 119, Range 35 West.

Section 2. Best Interest of the City of Willmar. That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and the territory affected.

Section 3. Abuts on City Limits. That the property above described abuts on the city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

Section 4. Zoning of Above Area. The area above described shall be zoned as follows:

CR - Conservation Recreation

Section 5. Repealing Portions of Ordinance No. 606. That part of Ordinance No. 606 adopted on December 5, 1973 and published on December 14, 1973 as it pertains to Parcel 1 therein is hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the filing of a

ORDINANCE NO. 606

(P-11)

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, to Include Certain Lands Owned by the City of Willmar.

WHEREAS, The following described land is owned by the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, Said property abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as to be properly subject to City Government and since annexation thereof will be in the best interests of the City of Willmar and of the territory to be annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Willmar as follows:

Section 1. Annexation. The following described property is hereby annexed and included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That part of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Parcel 1—Pond Area (7.5 Acres)

The S. 575' of the W. 660' of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, T119N, R35W, comprising approx. 7.5 acres and subject to easements for street right-of-way purposes along the West (50' for 22nd St. SW) and along the South (35' for 15th Ave. SW).

Parcel 2—Park Area (4.1 Acres)

That part of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 119 North, Range 35 West, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence on an assumed bearing of N 00° 51' W. on the easterly line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 75.00'; thence on a bearing of west parallel to the southerly line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 785.00 feet to the SE corner of a parcel owned by School District No. 347; thence on a bearing of North along the East boundary to the NE corner of said school property a distance of 754.59 feet to the point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence continuing on a bearing of North a distance of 159.5 feet to the south right-of-way of proposed 15th Avenue SW, City of Willmar, Minnesota; thence along said right-of-way on a bearing of N 75° 18' 45" West a distance of 308.6 feet; thence continuing along said right-of-way on a bearing of N 70° 23' 30" West a distance of 409.97 feet; thence on a bearing South a distance of 374.65 feet to the NW corner of the before-mentioned school property; thence on a bearing of East along the North boundary of said school property a distance of 682.83 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 4.1 acres more or less.

Parcel 3—Street R/W, 15th St. SW (1.6 Acres)

The easterly 35' of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, T119N, R35W, located south of the south line of Karen Ave. (13th Ave. SW).

Section 2. Best Interest of the City of Willmar. That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and the territory affected.

Section 3. Abuts on City Limits. That the property above described abuts on city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

Section 4. Zoning the Above Area. The area above described shall be zoned as follows:

Parcel 1—CR—Conservation Recreation

Parcel 2—R2—One & Two Family Residence

Parcel 3—R2—One & Two Family Residence

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the filing of a copy of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Willmar Township, the County Auditor, Kandiyohi County, and the Secretary of State, State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.
