### ORDINANCE NO. 79

## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, MINNESOTA

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY. Y'NNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.033, the City Council of the City of Watertown, having prior hereto on June 18, 1974, accepted a Petition for Annexation to the corporate limits of the City of Water town by all of the property owners of those certain lands as hereinafter set forty and copies of said Petition having been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Board of Commissioners, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law and rules of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and more than sixty (60) days having elapsed since such filing and no written objections having been made, or otherwise, and the Council having determined that said lands about the present corporate limits of the City of Watertown and do not exceed 200 acres and are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government and that annexation of said lands would be to the best interests of the City of Watertown and the lands to be annexed, the corporate limits of the City of Watertown are declared hereby extended to encompass and include all that certain land described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block 2; and Outlots 4, 5, 6 and 7, all in Longpre's Addition, according to the plat thereof on record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Carver County, Minnesota.

Outlots 6 and 19, and that part of vacated Green Street lying between said Outlot 6 and 19, according to the original plat of the Townsite of Watertown, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Carver County, Minnesota.

Also, that part of Madison Street lying between Newton Street and the Southeasterly line of Outlot 19 extended Southwesterly, according to the plat of the original Townsite of Watertown, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Carver County, Minnesota.

The above lands containing approximately 7.50 acres of land.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies with the Municipal Countisol of the State of Minnesota, the Town Clerk of the Town of

Watertown, the Carver County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota as required by law.


