COMMISSIONER'S SCIENTIFIC AND NATURAL AREA ORDER NO. 1

WHEREAS THE LANDS DESCRIBED AS: Lots 1 to 73, both inclusive, of Island Park, a subdivision of Island Number 4 in Sections 21 and 28, Township 37 North, Range 22 West, Chisago County, Minnesota, contain inherent, unique natural values including a large heron rookery;

AND WHEREAS the most effective means by which such lands can be used and protected for educational and research purposes in such manner and by such means as will leave them conserved for future generations, is by designation as a Scientific and Natural Area.

NOW, THEREFORE: I, ROBERT L. HERBST, Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources, pursuant to authority vested in me by law, do hereby designate the above described lands as the Rush Lake Island Scientific and Natural Area.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the provisions of NR 300 through and including NR 303 shall apply to the use of the above designated area. Dated this 8th day of August, 1974.
