I, Village Clerk of the Village of Bovey, hereby certify that the following is a true statement of the result of the counting and canvass of the votes by ballot at the Special Election of the Village of Bovey, County of Itasca and State of Minnesota, held on the 5th day of November 1921, as proclaimed to the voters by the Clerk of Election on the following question then and there submitted to the voters of the Village of Bovey, to-wit:

1. That the Village of Bovey, Minnesota, be separated from the Towns of Iron Range and Trout Lake for election and assessment purposes;

Said Town of Iron Range being Township 56, North, of Range 24 West and said Town of Trout Lake being Township 55 North, of Range 24 West, in Minnesota.

2. That the Village of Bovey, Minnesota, be made and constitute a separate election and assessment district.

Those voting "YES" seventy five (75).

Those voting "NO" seven (7).


