

ORDINANCE NO. 74-6

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LINDSTROM TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, or borough; and

WHEREAS, 60% or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the city and is deemed to be urban in character;

The city council of Lindstrom ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Lindstrom, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, 60% or more of the perimeter of which territory is bordered by territory already included within the city limits:

That part of Sections 33 and 34, Township 33 North, Range 20 West, located in Chisago County, Minnesota:

Beginning at a point being the intersection of the East line of said Section 33 and projection of the South line of Newell Avenue; thence East along said South line projected a distance of 183.5 feet; thence Southwesterly along the present boundary of the city 300.6 feet; thence Westerly and Northerly along the present boundaries of the city to East line of said Section 33; thence South along said Section line to the center line of township road that extends East from the Southern terminus of Akerson Street; thence West to the Southeast corner of Lot 3, Block 10 of Lakeland Addition (prior to vacation), being a point 200.7 feet East of the East line of Broadway Street and 223.6 feet South of the South line of Newlander Avenue projected; thence Northerly along the present city limits 223.6 feet; thence Westerly 200.7 feet along the said South line of Newlander Avenue, projected; thence North 66 feet to the North line of Newlander Avenue projected; thence East along said North line of Newlander Avenue 200.7 feet; thence North along the current city boundary to the South line of Newell Avenue thence Easterly to the point of beginning. Containing 19.9 acres more or less.

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Ordinance No. 74-6

Section 2. Filing. The city clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

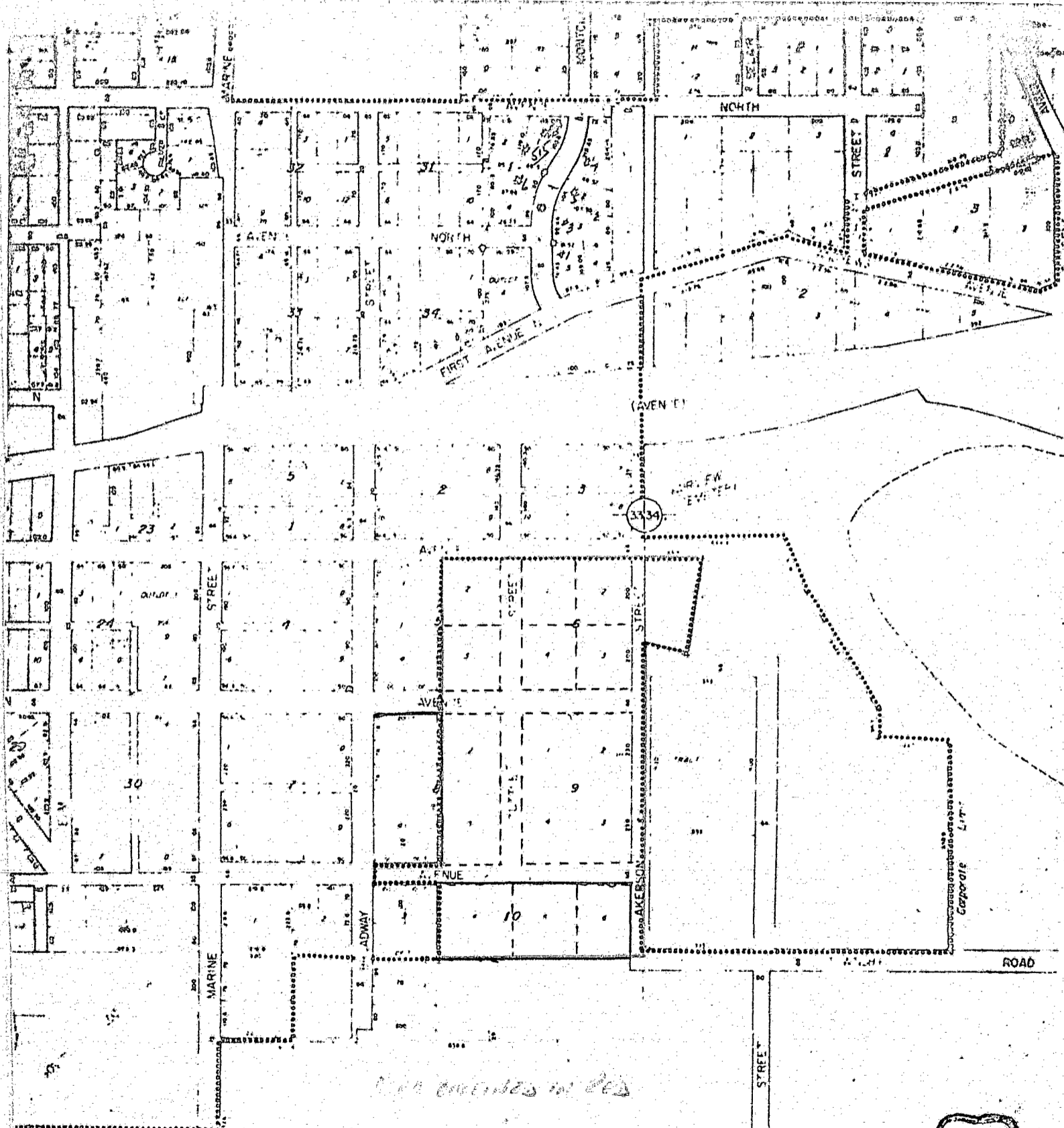
