PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, Pursuing by Chapter Seven (7), General Statutes of Minnesota, 1910, and other mandatory clauses, a petition was filed with the Secretary of State on the twenty-fifth day of February, 1911, praying for the creation of a new county out of territory now lying in Cass County, and providing:

That the name of the proposed new county shall be Glover County;

That the boundaries thereof shall be as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Township One Hundred Thirty-nine, Range of Number Thirty-one West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, thence south on the County Line between Cass and Hubbard Counties to the southwest corner of said Township One Hundred Thirty-nine, Range Thirty-one, thence west on the County Line between Cass and Hubbard Counties to the northwest corner of Township One Hundred Thirty-eight, Range Thirty-two, thence south on the County Line between Cass and Wadena Counties to the intersection of said west line of said Cass County with the Crow Wing River in Section thirty, Township One Hundred Thirty-four, Range Thirty-two, thence following the said Crow Wing River in an easterly, southerly and southwesterly direction on the south line of said Cass County to a point where said Crow Wing River intersects the south line of Section Thirty-three in Township One Hundred Thirty-three, Range Twenty-nine, thence east on the said south line of said Section Thirty-three, Township One Hundred Thirty-three, Range Twenty-nine, to a point where said line intersects the Mississippi River, thence following said Mississippi River to the intersection of said Mississippi River with the south line of said Section Thirty-three, Township One Hundred Thirty-three, Range Twenty-nine, thence east on said south line of said Section Thirty-three, to the intersection of same with the Mississippi River, thence northward and northeasterly along the Mississippi River to the intersection of same with the east line of Section Thirty-three, Township One Hundred Thirty-three, Range Twenty-nine, thence north on the county line between Cass and Crow Wing Counties to the northeast corner of Section Four, in Township One Hundred Thirty-six, Range Twenty-nine, thence west on the county line between Cass and Crow Wing Counties to the southeast corner of Section Thirty-three, Township One Hundred Thirty-seven, Range Twenty-nine, thence north on the county line between Cass and Crow Wing Counties to the northeast corner of Section Four, in Township One Hundred Thirty-eight, Range Twenty-nine, thence east on the county line between Cass and Crow Wing Counties to the southeast corner of Township One Hundred Thirty-nine, Range Twenty-eight, thence north on the range line between Ranges Twenty-seven and Twenty-eight to the northeast corner of Township One Hundred Thirty-nine, Range Twenty-eight, thence West on the congressional township line between Township One Hundred Thirty-nine and One Hundred Forty, to the place of beginning, said proposed new county containing the following Townships: Blind Lake, Ponto Lake, Powers, Deerfield, McKinley, Bull Moose, Pine River, Barclay, Wilson, Walden, Bunker, Ansel, Poplar, Moose Lake, Maple, Loon Lake, Horse Brook, Meadow Brook, Byron, Becker, May, Sylvan and unorganized territory in Township One Hundred Thirty-four, Range Twenty-nine, and Township One Hundred Thirty-four, Range Thirty, all in the said County of Cass, in the State of Minnesota.

That the name and location of the county seat of said proposed new

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county is the village of Pine River, of Cass County, Minnesota.

That Olaf Oleson residing on the Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Two, in Township One Hundred Thirty-six, Range Thirty, Cass County, Minnesota, whose post office address is Pequot, Minnesota; G. A. Zuledorf residing in the village of Pillager, Minnesota, whose post office address is Pillager, Minnesota; Cal Witherell residing on the southeast quarter of Section Twenty-two, Township One Hundred Thirty-six, Range Thirty-two, whose post office address is Poplar, Minnesota; J. E. Krake, residing in the village of Backus, Minnesota, whose post office address is Backus, Minnesota; E. L. Forbes, residing in the village of Pine River, Minnesota, whose post office address is Pine River, Minnesota, shall constitute the first county board of said proposed new county.

AND, WHEREAS, The said petition has been duly considered and found and certified to as conforming in all respects to the provisions of law,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, do hereby direct and proclaim that the question of the creation of the proposed new county of Clever be submitted to the voters of Cass County at the next general election to be held in this state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1923.



CERTIFICATE.

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN,

IN MOYER COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That I, the undersigned, am the Chief Magistrate of the City of Austin, in Moyer County, Minnesota; that I am the Mayor of said City; that the seal attached is the corporate seal of said City; that an election was duly held in said City on October 25th, A.D., 1921; that notice thereof was duly and legally given; that the election was duly and legally held; that the ballots were duly and legally cast, voted, counted, canvassed and returned; that the results of said election were duly and legally returned, published and declared; that the following amendment/s to the Charter of said City was duly and legally proposed and adopted by three-fifths of those lawfully voting at said election and that said three-fifths of those lawfully voting at said election, did duly and legally declare in favor of said amendment so proposed and hereinafter set forth in full, and that three-fifths of the qualified voters of said City voting at said election did ratify th said following amendment, to-wit:

Chapter VI Section 15 of the Charter of the City of Austin is hereby amended by adding to and at the end of Section 15, the following:

SEWERAGE

For the purpose of constructing a municipal disposal plant with and including all necessary intercepting sewers or system of intercepting sewers, the common council shall have the power and authority to borrow money and to issue the city's bonds, but the city's net indebtedness, as defined by General Statutes, Minnesota, 1913, Section 1843, shall not, inclusive of such bonds, exceed ten per cent of the taxable property therein, including moneys and credits.

The bonds so to be issued shall be in such form and denomination, bear such rate of interest, and shall mature at such time or times as the common council may by resolution determine. The power and authority hereby granted shall be additional and supplementary to all other powers granted the common council, and may be exercised by it without submitting the proposition of the issuance of such bonds to the city's electors or to any class of the city's electors notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in the Charter or any applicable statutes contained.

This amendment shall take effect seven (7) days from and after its due adoption and approval at any election of the qualified voters of the City of Austin, at which said amendment shall be submitted.

This certificate is made in pursuance of Section 36 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, and Chapter 9 of the General Statutes of Minnesota, 1913, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto and the Charter of the City of Austin; and I hereby certify that the recitals of this certificate are true and that this certificate is made in duplicate.
