WHEREAS: working women constitute 33 million of the Nation's working force, and are constantly striving to serve their communities, their states, and their nation in civic and cultural programs; and

WHEREAS: major goals of business and professional women are to help create better conditions for business women through the study of social, economic, educational and political problems; to help them be of greater service to their community, to further friendship with women throughout the world; and

WHEREAS: all of us are proud of their leadership in these many fields of endeavor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 20 - 26, 1974 as
