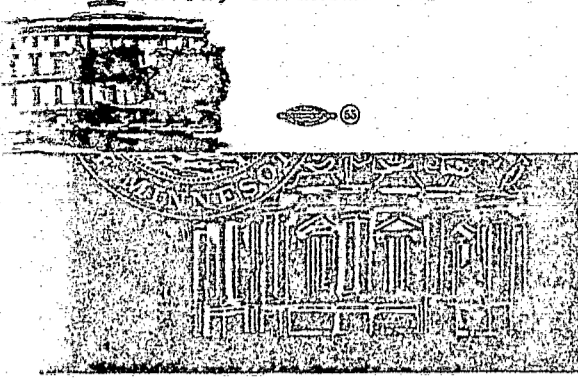

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Country Music in our nation has contributed greatly to our heritage and has helped to tell the history of our land and our people; and

WHEREAS: appreciation of Country Music continues to grow throughout the country with increased artistic expression by the American entertainment industry; and

WHEREAS: the special celebration of Country Music, "The Sound of America" is taking place this October in our country and others; and
