WHEREAS: the vast majority of youth are concerned, knowledgeable and responsible citizens; and

WHEREAS: the accomplishments and achievements of these young citizens deserve recognition and praise of their elders; and

WHEREAS: Optimist International, a public service organization, and the Metropolitan Council of Optimists Clubs have planned activities recognizing outstanding young people during the week of November 10 through November 17; and

WHEREAS: Youth Appreciation Week has for many years been observed in Minnesota and throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS: Optimists during Youth Appreciation Week select deserving young people for special recognition of their service in school, the community, and to the family;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 10 through 17, 1974 as
