



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the purpose of Clean Air observances is to promote united educational program for cleaner air and to help build a better, stronger America; and*

WHEREAS: *the air pollution is a serious community problem for both indoor and outdoor air, brought about through industrial expansion and increasing population, and since industry and populations give every indication of continuing to increase at an impressive rate soot, smoke and noxious fumes and gases promise to become a greater hazard to the health and welfare of the people of our Sovereign State, as well as a source of grave economic waste; and*

WHEREAS: *in these days when the Nation's inflation is rapidly increasing and energy is becoming more scarce, air pollution abatement assumes increasing importance in its prevention of wasted materials and energy, its cutting the cost of fuel, factory upkeep and maintenance, and its reduction of illness and absenteeism; and*

WHEREAS: *with some of the mechanical means already available combined with the enlightened attitude of industry, air pollution control measures must be continued and further measures instituted to win the race against air pollution; and*

WHEREAS: *air pollution can be found both indoors and outdoors; and*

WHEREAS: *for these reasons the abatement of air pollution in all of its various forms is of utmost concern to American citizens;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October, 1974 as

CLEANER AIR MONTH EVERYWHERE

AND FURTHER proclaim the week of October 20-26 as

CLEANER AIR WEEK
