ORDER FOR RETIREMENT




WHEREAS, the said Judge Thomas J. Scanlan has submitted evidence that he has attained the age of 71 years, and has served as such judge, or as such judge and as such judge of a court of record, for more than 23 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490.12, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Thomas J. Scanlan, to become effective at the close of business on December 31, 1974. He shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation as provided under the law, and I further direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Notice of Retirement as County Judge

I, Thomas J. Scanlan, also known as Thomas Joseph Scanlan,  
being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

That I am a Judge of the County Court, Dodge-Olmsted  
Counties, Minnesota. I was Probate Judge of Olmsted County  
from February 21, 1951 to July 1, 1972, at which latter time  
I succeeded to the position of County Court Judge under the laws  
establishing the County Court system in Minnesota.

I wish to retire effective December 31, 1974 at the  
expiration of my present term. My intention to retire was  
announced earlier in this year and a successor has been elected  
to this position, who will assume office January 1, 1975.

I am electing to retire under M.S.A. Chapter 490.12,  
Subdivision 2, pursuant to the option given by M.S. 490.124,  
Subdivision 8, being Laws of 1973, Chapter 744, Section 4,  
Subdivision 8, the Judges' Uniform Retirement Law. This  
provides for a retirement annuity of fifty per cent of my annual  
salary at time of retirement. My annual salary at time of  
retirement is \$27,500.00 a year pursuant to Laws 1974, Chapter  
495, effective August 1, 1974, setting County Judges' salaries  
at \$27,500.00 a year.

I am 71 years of age, born July 8, 1903. I am a graduate  
of the University of Minnesota, College of Law, and was  
admitted to the Minnesota State Bar in the Fall of 1935.


