URDINANCE NO. 51 ELECTIONS ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ELECTIONS HELD IN THE CITY OF EAGAN, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 45.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGAN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 51.01 - PURPOSE AND INTENT.

It is the intent of this ordinance to effectuate biennial elections as established by Laws 1973, Chapter 123. The intent herein shall be effected without shortening terms of incumbents or lengthening terms by more than one year. This ordinance provides a uniform time for holding elections and taking office.

SECTION 51.02 - ELECTION TERMS

The following officers shall be elected for the terms and in the years shown in the following table:

SECTION 51.03 - SUBSEQUENT ELECTIONS

From the date of next subsequent elections hereinabove specified, officers shall be elected at regular intervals for the terms hereinabove set forth.

SECTION 51.04 - EFFECTIVE DATES OF TERMS

New terms shall begin and each old term shall expire on the first business day of January in the year follwing the election of the officer.

SECTION 51.05 - ELECTION DATE

Elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November in each odd numbered year beginning with 1975. STATE OF MINNESOTA

SECTION 51.06 - REPEALER

Eagans' Ordinance No. 45 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 51.07 - REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

The system for registration of voters provided by Minnesota Statutes 1971,

Chapter 201 and by Laws 1973, Chapters 123 and 675, is hereby adopted for registering voters in the City of Eagan, Minnesota,

SECTION 51.03 - INVALIDITY.

The invalidity of any part of this ordinance as declared by a court of competent jurisdiction shall not affect the validity of the remainder thereof.

SECTION 51.09 - CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED.

All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 51.10 - EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication according to law.
