ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAKE UP OF THE CITY COUNCIL, THE TERMS OF OFFICE, EXTENSION OF TERMS OF OFFICE WHERE NECESSARY, AND FIXING THE DATE OF THE REGULAR BIENNIAL CITY ELECTION PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES, CHAPTERS 123 AND 412.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF DONALDSON, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Make up of Council. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 412, the City Council shall be composed of five members consisting of the mayor to be elected for two year terms beginning with the 1976 election, and four councilmen elected for four year terms. A Clerk and Treasurer after expiration of their terms shall be appointed by the Council for indefinite terms.

Section 2. Date of Election. The regular city election shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every even-numbered year beginning with the 1974 election.

Section 3. Extension of Terms. The terms of the mayor and the two councilmen whose current terms will expire on the first business day of January, 1976, are extended to the first business day of January, 1977, and those offices shall be filled at the 1976 city election.

Section 4. Terms and Transition. Terms of city elective officers shall commence on the first business day of January following election at which the officer is chosen. Two councilmen shall be elected for four year terms at the biennial election to be held in 1974.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
