

Village Resolution No. 60-1921-22

Whereas, at a special election held on the 12th day of December, A.D. 1921, for the purpose of voting upon the proposition of the Village of Gilbert, St. Louis County, Minnesota, separating from the Town of Missabe Mountain and becoming, a "separate election and assessment district", in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided, and at said election there were four seventy-five (475) votes cast, of which three hundred eighty-nine (389) were in favor of the above proposition, eighty-four (84) of which were against said proposition, and two (2) of which were defaced or spoiled, and

Whereas, after a careful canvass of the result of the above votes as filed with the Clerk by the proper election officers, this Council now finds and declares the above to be a true and correct canvass of the result of said special election, and

Whereas, it appears from the above canvass that the proposition received a majority of three hundred five (305) votes, be it, therefore,

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Resolved, that said proposition is hereby declared duly carried by a majority of three hundred five (305) votes, be it further

Resolved, that the Village Clerk of the Village of Gilbert, St. Louis County, Minnesota, be and he hereby is directed and instructed to certify the result of said vote to the County Auditor of St. Louis County, Minnesota, as provided by statute.
