
Dear Sir:-

You will please take notice, that the undersigned, will, within 30 days file an application in the General Land Office, at Washington, D.C., for the survey of that certain unsurveyed Island located in Burntside Lake, St. Louis County, Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

An unsurveyed island located in the central portion of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 52, Township 63 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying South 40 degrees West 52 chains from the P.C. on the Northwest corner of Lot 1 of said Section, and 5 chains East of the Northeast shore line of Lot 4 of said Section 52-63-13, containing approximately 0.50 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
