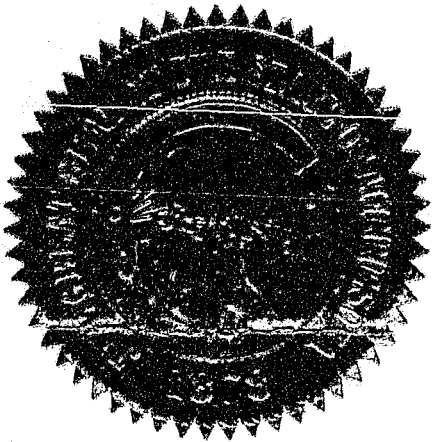
PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, The peace officers of St. Louis county, after diligent efforts, have been unable to apprehend the person or persons guilty of the murder of Ben Wilkins of the village of Cook, in said county; and

WHEREAS, Public welfare demands the arrest and punishment of the guilty person or persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Freus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for the arrest and conviction, or for information leading to the arrest and conviction, of the person or persons guilty of the murder of the said Ben Wilkins.
